Have you Lost or Found a Dog?

If you find or lose a dog you should contact your local council **FIRST**

Your local Council is legally responsible for taking in stray dogs and they employ a dog warden to do this.

Outside Office Hours, or if the Dog Warden is unavailable
please take stray dogs to the nearest staffed Police Station

The Police are not obliged to pick up or collect stray dogs
but only to accept any brought to Police Stations

The local authorities and police are the only bodies legally allowed to deal with stray dogs.
This is why animal welfare organizations cannot get involved with strays.

The Dog Warden or police may ask the South Bucks Branch to kennel the dogs and
after 7 to 8 statutory days the dogs maybe available for re-homing.
